A Grand Rapids man, who feels he is alive today because of the Air Rescue service, spoke to East Elementary PTA members last week and later to children at both East and Central Elementary schools.

He is Jim DeVoss, now a systems analyst for Amway Corp. An ex-Air Force fighter pilot, he was forced to bail out over Vietnam jungles behind enemy lines. His rescue was photographed and included in an Air Force film describing
